Dear Mr Tarrero,

Thank you for contacting the President of the European Parliament, Roberta Metsola, about your proposals concerning Europe's long-term future.

Your letter has been read carefully, and the Citizens' Enquiries Unit has been asked to reply.

Defence of shared principles

In [February 2026](#), welcoming the President of the United Nations General Assembly, President Metsola said: *"In a more uncertain world, we need to double down on our commitment that cooperation and dialogue between nations delivers better results than confrontation. The European Parliament was built on the belief that cooperation is our greatest strength. And that belief continues to guide our work."*

In its [January 2026 resolution on the implementation of the Common Foreign and Security Policy](#), Parliament stresses that the current geopolitical environment requires the European Union to strengthen cooperation with like-minded partners, uphold the rules-based international order and defend democracy, the rule of law and human rights.

Artificial intelligence

President Metsola has consistently underlined that Europe should be a leader in artificial intelligence. At the [Meta AI Symposium in March 2026](#), she said: *"AI is a moment Europe cannot afford to miss."* The European Parliament supports investment in AI, digital infrastructure and technological sovereignty while promoting innovation based on European values and international

cooperation. This is notably underlined in its January 2026 [resolution on the European technological sovereignty](#).

Cultured meat

In June 2026, the [European Parliament](#) and the [Council](#) (EU governments) approved new rules strengthening the position of farmers in the food supply chain. Among other measures, the legislation reserves certain meat designations for products derived from animals and introduces a transition period before these provisions apply.

Cryopreservation

The European Parliament has previously received a [petition](#) on this subject. The European Commission [concluded](#) that the issues raised currently fall outside the competences of the European Union and remain primarily the responsibility of the Member States.

Longevity science

The European Parliament recognises the importance of healthy ageing (see 2021 [resolution on old continent growing older](#)) and has called for increased research through Horizon Europe and other EU funding programmes to improve healthy life expectancy and support innovation in health research.
